ORDER

UPON the Class Representative's application by letter dated 16 August 2024 requesting the Tribunal to draw this Order (the "**Application**")


AND HAVING REGARD TO the Tribunal's powers under the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Defendants shall be required to provide factual detail of the technical process/es for facilitating payments for Relevant App Purchases, including responses to the following questions and supported by a statement of truth, by **4pm on 13 September 2024**:
 - 1.1. confirmation that payment services for Relevant App Purchases are facilitated by a different system/s to those of Relevant Subscription Purchases and Relevant In-App Purchases; or, alternatively, an explanation of what is meant

by paragraphs 81 and 44(c) of the Defence;

- 1.2. a full explanation of every service comprised in the payment services associated with Relevant App Purchases (whether conducted by Apple itself or by a third party on Apple's behalf), including clarification as to whether Table 1 in the expert report of Mr Burelli dated 14 May 2024 is incomplete or contains services not provided by Apple (or on Apple's behalf) and an appropriate explanation if so; and
 - 1.3. technical information on the mechanism / software being used to enable payments for Relevant App Purchases to be taken for apps downloaded from the App Store to an iOS Device.
2. The Defendants shall pay the Class Representative's costs of and occasioned by the Application, to be assessed if not agreed.
 3. There be liberty to apply.
